Category of Material Topics	Significance
Top Priority Issues	Critical to Deepak as well as to its stakeholders
Key Issues	Medium to high priority issues for Deepak as well as its stakeholders
Hidden Value Creators	Important for Deepak's business but low priority for stakeholders
Hygiene Factors	High priority for Deepak's stakeholders but low priority for the business of the Company
Monitoring Issues	Low importance to both Deepak as well as its stakeholders

Management/Mitigation Approach

- Deepak's commitment to environment extends to ensuring no harm to the quality and availability of water due to its operations
- This commitment will safeguard both the ecosystem and overall community
- Deepak is also dedicated to minimise its water and carbon footprint through various initiatives

- A well-established protocol enables Deepak to evaluate the Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) impacts of its products during their development stages, ensuring these considerations form part of Deepak's decisionmaking processes
- Most of the products have successfully undergone a carbon footprint assessment and Deepak plans to conduct Life Cycle Assessments (LCA) for several existing products in future

Sustainable Supply Chain (G)

Significance and Impact

- A sustainable supply chain is critical for operations and business continuity
- Considering the size of operations, a company can influence the ESG priorities for their suppliers
- It will also have a high impact on stakeholders

Management/Mitigation Approach

- Deepak monitors raw materials and finished goods in real-time. This is supported by using GPS-enabled secured means for transportation that allows seamless tracking and ensures a robust logistics and distribution network
- A structured warehousing ensures prompt customer deliveries while Deepak's integrated facilities, manufacturing expertise, and operational excellence paves the way to reliable and steady performance

Waste Management (E)

Significance and Impact

- Failure to comply with required waste management standard practices will have high negative impact on a company's operations
- Outward impact of this material issue is medium

Management/Mitigation Approach

- Generation of hazardous waste is a by-product of agrochemicals production, making it crucial to prioritise recycling and reusing waste whenever possible
- Deepak has adopted a proactive approach to ensure optimal use of resources and minimise as well as recycle waste in line with the regulatory requirements, supported by responsible practices

Energy Management (E)

Significance and Impact

- Efficient energy management can result in lower manufacturing emissions and reduced costs
- This matter has a moderate impact on external stakeholders

- Maximising energy efficiency across all business activities is paramount at Deepak to minimise the environmental impact and achieve sustainability goals and targets, aligned with its energy conservation strategy
- Deepak tracks daily energy consumption and actively monitors performance through systems installed across multiple locations
